Emmaus is designed from the outset to be more than a three day event; it includes follow-up fellowship opportunities aimed at supporting people's discipleship in the world. Emmaus not only takes persons to the Mountaintop but helps them return to everyday life and live as disciples through covenant groups for mutual support and accountability. Through Gatherings, Reunion groups and teaming, the goal of Emmaus is to give persons the means to persevere in grace for the rest of their lives.
